A.E.D. LOCATED ON THE WALL IN HALLWAY

Charge Person (Boathouse captain or Safety boat driver): Should have some knowledge/training in care of injuries.

Role:

- I. Establish scene safety
- II. Provide immediate care to rower
- III. Determine whether further assistance is needed by EMS (if needed) –call 911 for ambulance
- IV. Give status of injured to EMS when they arrive
- V. Notify the injured rower's contact person (listed on rower's information card, stored in the boathouse on top of filling cabinet)
- VI. Complete incident report (located in Log book)

EAP in case of Fire in Boathouse

Rescue anyone in danger

Alarm (call 911)

Contain the fire (eg. Close doors)

Evacuate (or Extinguish if safe to do so)

The boathouse fire extinguishers are located at each of the three exits (doors) of the boathouse. All members are to gather in the parking lot across from the boathouse. Bring the rowing log to ensure everyone is accounted for.
